The National Science Foundation (NSF) and the National Security Agency (NSA) sponsored GenCyber Teacher Training Cybersecurity Academy at York College provides middle-school and high-school STEM teachers with a professional development program that incorporates cybersecurity concepts, classroom, and extracurriculars. Each participant will learn to develop lesson plans and educational games on cybersecurity topics to support classroom learning. In addition, participants are offered 48 Continuing Teacher and Leader Education (CTLE) credit hours.

The York College GenCyber Camp allows teachers to learn about cybersecurity concepts, technology, and the First Principles. Our curriculum includes fun educational games and activities that use learner-centered, problem-based, and peer-assisted learning approaches to engage and empower our camp participants. In addition, several core cybersecurity concepts will be covered, including Fundamental cybersecurity concepts, cyber hygiene, cybercrimes, basics of cryptography, social engineering, web and mobile security, cyber technology, ethics, and more.

The program includes 12 hours of pre-camp activities, one week of in-person camp training, and 12 hours of post-camp activities.
